This Taskforce is a most welcome and useful initiative to enhance the effective implementation of the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality. Please be assured with the full support of the European Affairs Committee. The Committee emphasises the importance of the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality.

The Committee, hereby, wants to convey its support for the letter which was sent to you on behalf of the Presidential Troika of the national parliaments of the COSAC on December 6, 2017, regarding the establishment of the "Timmermans Taskforce".

The Committee stresses the importance of being involved at an early stage in European decision-making, especially on the important topic of subsidiarity and proportionality. Therefore, the Committee regrets that it received the letter regarding the establishment of the Task Force and its composition at such a late stage. The Committee would certainly have considered its participation in the Taskforce, if it were possible to extend the number of national parliaments' representatives.

The First Vice President Timmermans already referred to this matter in his letter of January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018 in which he explained why the Task Force was established on a short notice.
