IVICA BOCEVSKI was elected as Member of the Government of the Republic of Macedonia, responsible for European affairs and coordination of foreign assistance.

Ivica Bocevski was born on 15 June 1977 in Skopje. He graduated political studies at the Faculty of Law, University of Sts. Cyril and Methodius in 1999. He completed postgraduate studies in the area of public and international affairs in the period between 2002-2004, at the University of Pittsburgh, USA, through the "Ron Brown" Programme of the US State Department for support of young professionals from Southeast Europe.

He is one of the founders and first Executive Director of the Institute for Democracy in Skopje. He worked in the Government of the Republic of Macedonia and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and as of March 2007 he was appointed as spokesperson of the Government of the Republic of Macedonia. He speaks English and German languages. He has participated at numerous seminars, forums, and trainings in the areas of political science, applied politics, and international relations organised by domestic and foreign educational and research institutions. He has published a number of expert articles in domestic and foreign journals, and for a time worked as columnist in "Utrinski Vesnik". He is married, father of Jovana.
